

The City of Windhoek approved 207 building plans worth N\$180.1 million in September, 45 more than in August. In value terms, approvals declined by N\$33.6 million to N\$180.1 million in September, reflecting a decline of 15.7% m/m and 52.0% y/y decline. The year-to-date value of approved building plans reached N\$1.56 billion, 3.8% lower than the comparative period a year ago. On a twelve-month cumulative basis, 2,007 building plans were approved worth approximately N\$2.16 billion, 3.7% higher in value terms compared to the same twelve-month period a year ago. The number of buildings completed declined from 31 in August to 28 during September. In value terms, building completions declined by 1.9% m/m to N\$28.6 million.

Year-to-Date Value of Approvals (N\$ million)






Additions to Properties

The largest portion of building plan approvals in September was made up of additions to properties. For the month of September, 168 additions were approved, 48.7% higher than the 113 additions that were approved during August. In value terms, the additions were worth N\$72.5 million, a 42.9% m/m increase from August. On a year-to-date basis, 1,181 additions to properties were approved, valued at N\$503.2 million, a 5.2% y/y increase in number and a 21.8% y/y decline in value terms, compared to the same period in 2024. 18 Additions to properties, valued at N\$10.13 million, were completed during September. On a twelve-month cumulative basis, 291 additions were completed, reflecting a 50.1% decline in number and a 48.1% y/y decline in value terms, compared to September 2024.

Number and Value of Additions to Properties Approved



Residential Units

New residential units accounted for 33 of the total 207 approvals registered in September, a 21.4% m/m decline compared to the 42 residentials units approved in August. In value terms, N\$59.6 million worth of residential units were approved during the month, 44.9% less than the N\$108.2 million worth of residentials approvals during August. 10 Residential units were completed, worth N\$ 18.5 million. On a year-to-date basis, 105 residential units have been completed, worth N\$ 179.4 million, a 36.2% decline in value terms, compared to the same period in 2024.

Number and Value of Residential Plans Approved (Windhoek)





Commercial and Industrial Units

Commercial and industrial building plans approved in September amounted to 6 units, worth N\$48.0 million. This is 1 unit fewer than approved in the prior month and a 12.4% m/m decrease in terms of value. On a year-to-date basis, 53 commercial and industrial building plans were approved, worth N\$507.2 million, a 14.8% y/y increase compared to the year-to-date value during September 2024. No commercial and industrial units were completed during September 2025.

The Bottom Line

In September, building plan approvals increased from the 162 approved in August to 207, with a total value of N\$180.1 million. At the end of Q3, the year-to-date value of approvals was down by 3.8% y/y in comparison to last year's level, however, up 4.0% in terms of the number of approvals. The cumulative 12-month value of approvals stood at N\$2.16 billion by the end of September, 3.7% higher than in the same period in 2024.
